

Parade Vehicle Inspection Criteria

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Drivers:

1. **ALL** drivers must possess a valid driver's license.
2. **ALL** drivers must possess registration for the vehicle they are operating.
3. **ALL CDL** drivers must be in compliance with the **FMCSA**. (Federal Motor Carrier Safety Admin)
4. **ALL CDL DRIVERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT MEDICAL CARD**
5. **The DRIVER is legally responsible for the actions of persons on vehicles and floats**

VEHICLES:

1. **ALL** CDL vehicles must be in compliance with FMCSA
2. **ALL** vehicles/floats/trailers/musical platforms must be properly registered & licensed by the Registry of Motor Vehicles
3. **ALL** vehicles must have a valid state inspection.
4. **ALL** vehicles must have working brake lights & turn signals
5. **ALL** vehicles must have properly functioning brakes, including air brakes.
6. **ALL floats & trailers** must use safety chains and be properly secured with a legal hitch
7. **ALL** props on floats & trailers must be properly secured, braced or tied down to prevent movement.

8. **ALL floats & trailers must provide adequate safety measures for all riders to prevent falling from platforms. Hand holds for each rider. NO GOING OFF AND ON TRUCK BEDS**
9. **NO throwing of any articles from the vehicles, floats or trailers.**
10. **NO vehicles with defective tires**
11. **NO vehicles with suspension defects.**
12. **NO vehicles with visible fuel leaks.**
13. **NO overweight vehicles**
14. **NO overloaded vehicles**
15. **NO over height vehicles**
16. **NO staging to be built on trailer bed unless load conforms to Local, State & Federal Regulations AND HAS BEEN APPROVED by ISD.**
17. **NO MUSIC OR NOISE EMANATION WITHIN STAGING AREA**

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

NO CYLINDERS or CONTAINERS OF ANY TYPE GASES OR FUELS
