With Pride only a few months away, it's time again to ponder the all-important question: what's the best way to rock out in the Pride Parade? Your first stop should be www.bostonpride.org to download an application. For the fourth year in a row, we are NOT RAISING THE

APPLICATION FEE (in fact, the fee for student groups has been reduced); but a late fee will apply after March 17th, so don't delay! The deadline for applications is June 2nd. Email parade@bostonpride.org with questions, or call 617-262-9405.

Please note that the Parade route is changing this year due to the City of Boston's planned renovations of the Boston Common. The new route will be announced shortly, so please remember to check our website and future editions of this newsletter for details.

The 2007 Boston Pride Week will run from Friday, June 1, 2007 through Sunday, June 10, 2007. The flag raising at City Hall will be on Friday, June 1, 2007; Pride Day at Faneuil Hall will be celebrated on Saturday, June 2, 2007; finals for the Pride Idol Contest will be held on Wednesday, June 6, 2007; the Parade and Festival will be on Saturday, June 9, 2007; and the Jamaica Plain Women's Block Party and the Stuart Street Block Party will be on Sunday, June 10, 2007.
